Experience/Qualifications:

**Administration and Communication Committee** – responsible for budget development and oversight, as well as per capita and mission giving.

**Camps and Conferences Committee** – oversees all aspects of Camp Hopewell ministry including its budget and fund raising efforts.

**Campus Ministry Committee** – this committee oversees the PC(USA) campus programs within our bounds. Funds development is a major aspect of members' responsibilities.

**Education, Worship, and Nurture Committee** – responsible for presbytery-level programs of learning, leadership development, and youth ministry, as well as responsibility for worship at presbytery meetings, and worship education in the presbytery. Oversees the Tapestry Planning Team, and the work of several other ongoing Task Forces.

**Evaluation Committee** – carries out the *Book of Order* requirement for regular review of “the functional relationship between presbytery’s structure and its mission” (G-11.0103v).

**Evangelism and Church Development Committee** – responsible for evangelism and church growth programs, and oversees the staff associate program (clergy who serve small congregations and also work for the presbytery)

**Governing Body Relations Committee** – responsible for sessional records review, as well as other matters related to the ecclesiastical relationship between congregations and the presbytery (e.g., *Book of Order* exemptions).

**Committee on Ministry** – a committee mandated by the *Book of Order*, all members must be ordained elders or Ministers. COM oversees all aspects of pastoral relationships and has certain delegated authority from the presbytery.

**Missions Committee** – sponsors and oversees various outreach projects and ministries of the presbytery utilizing budgeted resources and special offering receipts. Oversees the Hunger Network, and is also responsible for all global mission efforts, and mission partnerships.

**New Church Development Committee** – responsible for planting new congregations within our bounds.

**Nominations Committee** – this committee’s membership is currently named through former moderators.

**Permanent Judicial Commission** – responsible for any *Book of Order* judicial processes should they occur, and presents an annual review of new *Book of Order* amendments in preparation for their consideration by the presbytery.

**Committee on Preparation for Ministry** – works with individuals in their discernment of a call to the vocation of ministry, and oversees their preparation for ordained ministry or certification.

**Representation Committee** – conducts an annual review of gender and racial ethnic composition of the presbytery’s committees and boards as required by the *Book of Order*.

**Trustees** – holds title to presbytery properties and handles certain legal and ecclesiastical functions.
